

PIED PIPER'S TABLERUNNER

FINISHED SIZE: 53½cm X 221cm / 21" x 87"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

FROM FABRIC A:

Cut for the large border of each end of your table runner: 21½" x 14½" Cut 2 pieces like this.

FROM FABRIC B:

Cut narrow strips for borders 2 & 4 of each end of your table runner:

Border 2: 21½" x 1½" Cut 2 like this.

Border 4: 21½" x 2½" Cut 2 like this.

FROM FABRIC C:

Cut for border 3 of each end of your table runner: 21½" x 7½" Cut 2 pieces like this.

For the center of your table runner, cut your blocks as follows: 4 blocks: 8½" x 7½"

FROM FABRIC D:

For the center of your table runner, cut your blocks as follows: 10 blocks: 7½" x 4½"

FROM FABRIC E:

For the center of your table runner, cut your blocks as follows:

4 blocks: 7½" x 6½"

1 block: 7½" x 8½"

FROM FABRIC F:

For the center of your table runner, cut your blocks as follows: 2 blocks: 7½" x 8½"

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

All seam allowances used are a ¼" and remember to iron each seam before adding another unit.

1. Join borders 1,2,3,& 4 together to form the ends of your table runner. Set aside.
2. Sew 3 strips of blocks to form the center of your table runner as follows:
 - a) Rows 1 & 3 are the same, using Fabric C, D & E. Sew blocks together in a strip as follows: E, D, C, D, C, D, E.
 - b) Row 2 uses Fabric D,E & F. Sew blocks together in a strip as follows: D, F, D, E, D, F, D.
3. Sew these 3 strips together to form the center unit of your table runner.

4. Attach a border unit to each end.

We did not quilt our version of the tablerunner but you can do so if you wish.

Cut your backing fabric to size and place your tablerunner & backing fabric right side together. Pin well the whole way round and using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance sew all round, leaving one end open to turn your tablerunner through. Double stitch at each end and trim the corners before turning to the right side.

Iron your tablerunner , turning in a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance at the open end. Pin this well and top-stitch round your whole tablerunner. This stitching will close the open end.

Your tablerunner is now ready to use! Amaze your friends & family!!!!!!
